Dear Dr. Marwell:

In response to our telephone discussion of January 6, 1997, I enclose a preliminary report prepared by Rollie Zavada. This report answers some of the questions raised during our visit in September.

Rollie coordinated a search of old records within Eastman Kodak Company regarding the edge codes on the films and the introduction dates of various products. He also talked with photographic experts outside the company on some issues. This information adds to the comments Rollie made during our discussions in September.

I have consulted with Kodak management regarding further work on this subject. I have received approval to contribute up to \$20,000 of labor and materials to the effort. This amount is equivalent to roughly 35 man-days of work. We are willing to negotiate further work beyond this level with suitable compensation.

As we discussed on the phone, I will await a description of the work you would like us to do. We will estimate the scope of each work item and get back to you.

I look forward to continuing our collaboration.
